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About this Report

As part of its participation in The National Citizen Survey™, the City of Snoqualmie conducted a mailed survey of 2,200 residents. Surveys were mailed to randomly selected households in May 2017 and data were collected through July 5, 2017. Toward the end of the official data collection period (see the report, *The National Citizen Survey: Community Livability Report, Snoqualmie, WA 2017*), the City made available a web-based survey to its residents through the City's eNewsletter and social media channels. Visitors to the site were able to complete the survey from June 21 – July 10, 2017 and 236 surveys were received.

This report contains the results of this administration of the web-based survey and have not been weighted to current population estimates of Snoqualmie.
