Over 2,000 dogs live in Snoqualmie. If they each create 1/4 pound of waste each day, that's 500 pounds – or a quarter of a ton – of raw sewage dumped outside every day. There is nothing natural about that!

- Harmful organisms can be transmitted in pet waste to people, especially children.
- Roundworms, Giardia, and Salmonella in pet waste can survive in the environment for months.
- Stormwater can carry dog waste into creeks, streams and the Snoqualmie River through storm drains, harming people and spawning fish.
- Landfills are designed to safely handle dog waste, cat litter, and dirty diapers. Playgrounds and yards are not.
