Location: The project site is in the City of Snoqualmie, WA, between SE Mill Pond Road and along 396th Avenue SE, within Sections 29, 30 and 32 of Township 24, Range 8 East, W.M.

Pursuant to SMC 19.04.150 and WAC 197-11-455(6-7), any person or agency has up to thirty (30) days in which to review and comment on a DEIS, unless the City extends the comment period by fifteen (15) days upon the request of any person. The proponent Snoqualmie Mill Ventures, LLC has already requested, and the City has granted, a 15-day extension of the comment period. The June 11, 2020 comment period specified above for this DEIS is 45 days.

Public Meeting: Due to the ongoing COVID-19 emergency, an in-person public meeting cannot be scheduled at this time. An online meeting where oral comment can be provided is scheduled for May 20, 2020, at 4:00pm.
