








**Q4 4. Provide opportunities during the school day for elementary schools and other student groups to take swimming and water safety lessons:


Q5 5. Increase the capacity (depth and width of the pool, or an additional diving well) to allow for water dive competitions:


Q6 6. Increase the depth and width of the pool to allow for water polo:




